


























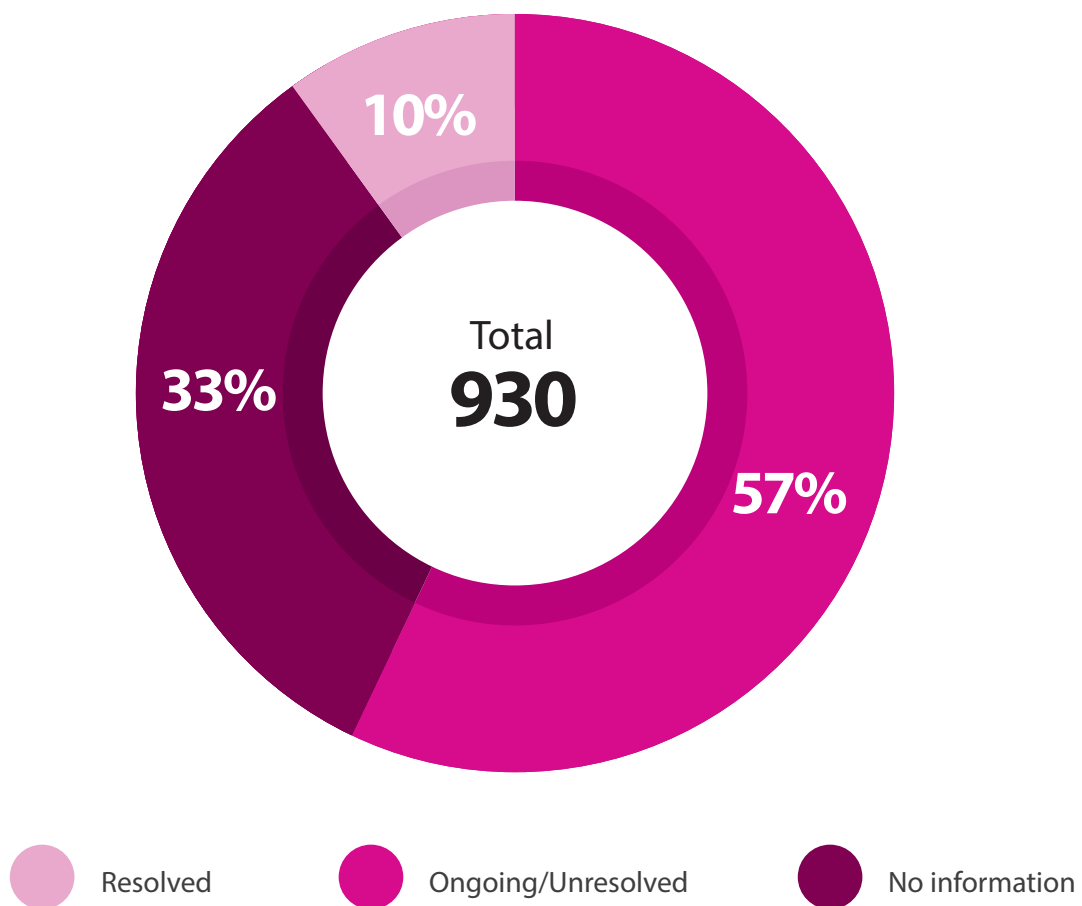


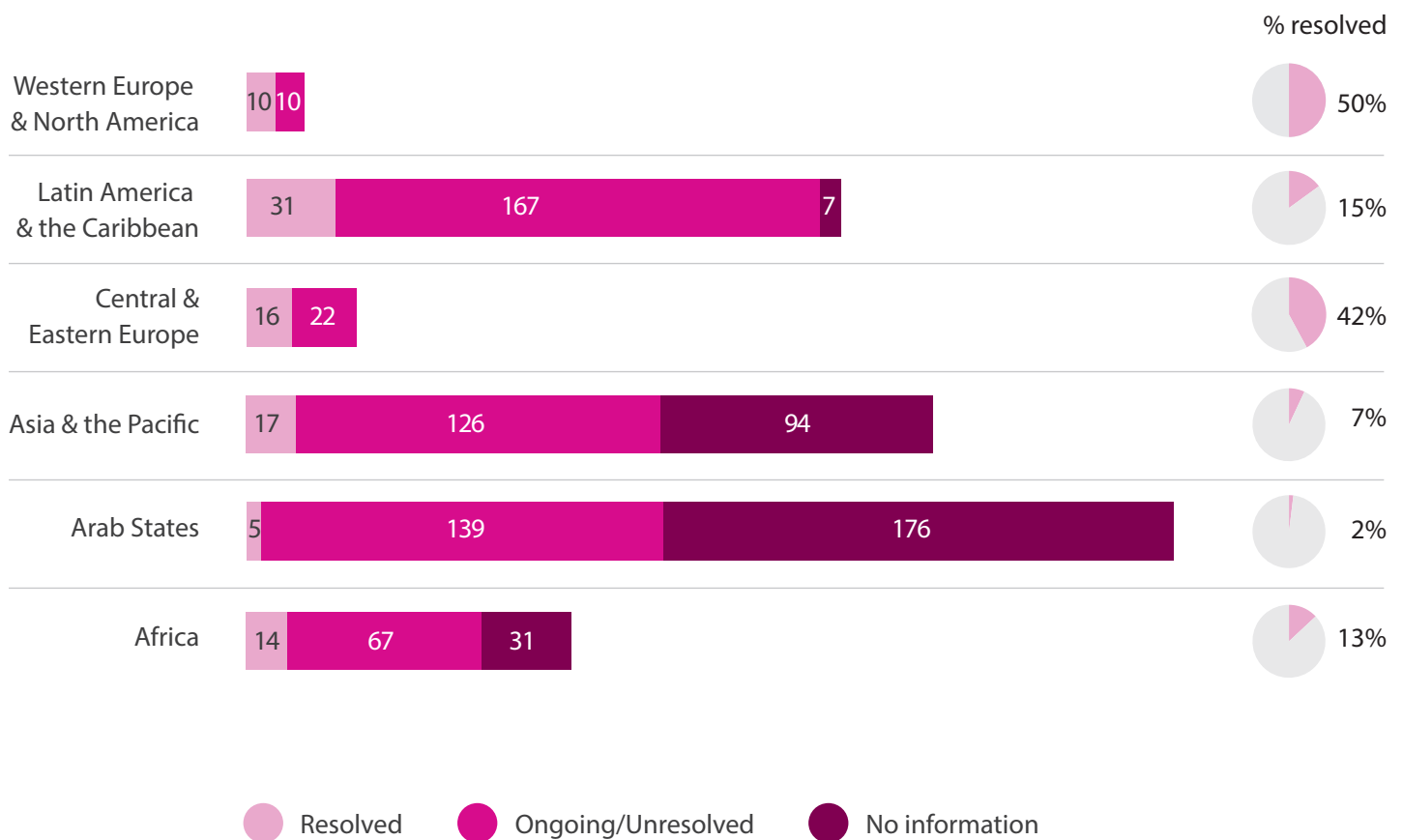

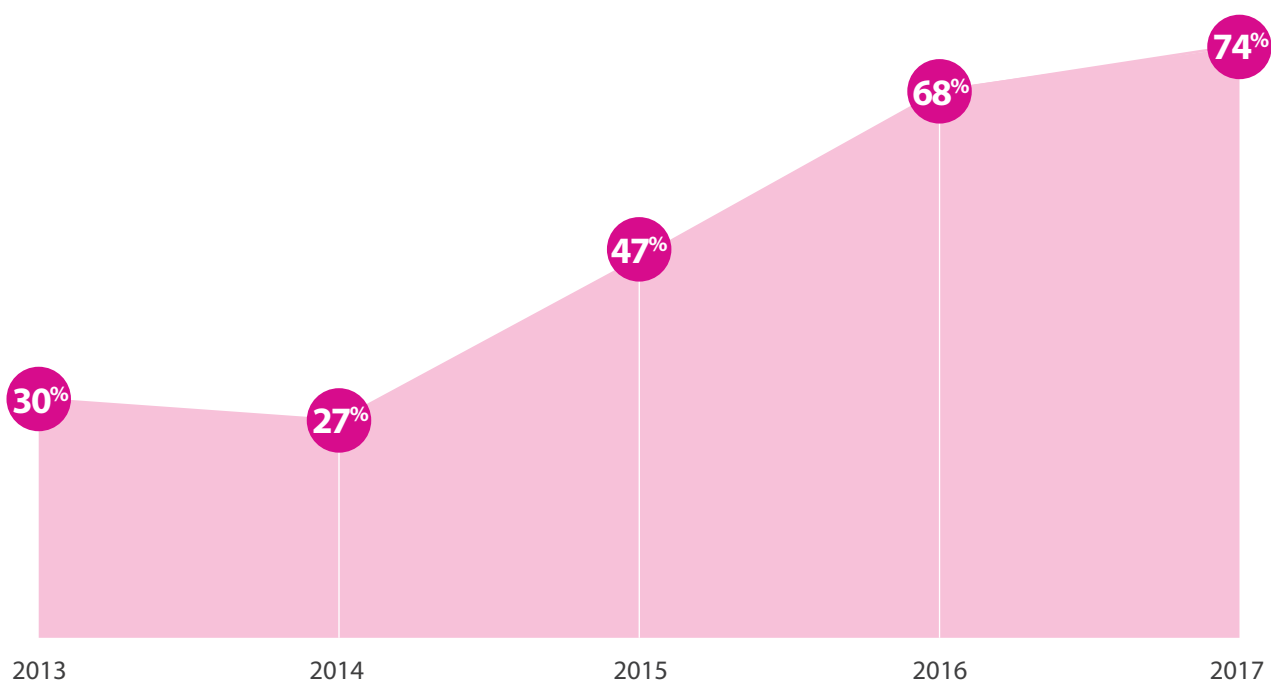
Status of judicial inquiry into killings of journalists, 2006-2016
